

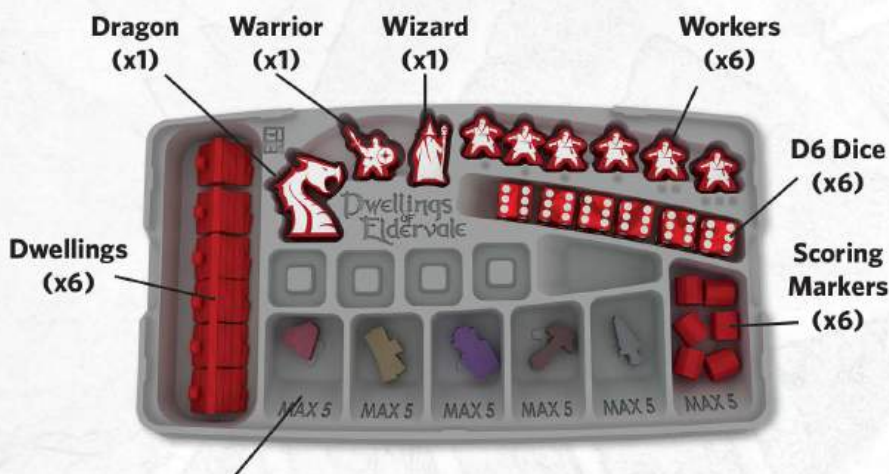
Dwellings of Eldervale

First Time Setup

The Dungeon, Player and Resource Trays are designed to hold game components during the game and between games. The following instructions are for first time setup. The rulebook covers how to setup a new game and store in the game box.

Player Trays

The 8 Player Trays each hold one set of 27 player pieces in an Elemental color. Find and place each of these components in each tray:



Optional: Resources Setup - Players start each game with 1 Gem, 1 Scroll, 1 Potion, 1 Tool and 1 Sword (not a Gold). These can be stored in the tray for the next game. The Starter card for each Element can also be kept in the tray.

Resource Trays

Each Resource tray holds approximately 10 Gems, Scrolls, Potions, Tools, Swords and Gold, and 30 sleeved Magic cards (or all 60 unsleeved in one tray). The tray lid depicts an icon labeling each well. If you own multiple sets of resources, you will only need one set for the game.



Dungeon Trays

The 2 Dungeon Trays are designed to hold all 104 Adventure cards and 96 Treasure tokens. Each Dungeon tray holds all components for 4 Elements.

Elemental Stickers

At the top of each tray column is a place for an Elemental sticker.



The stickers depict the Elemental Sigil for the Element and the primary and secondary resource type for that Element (for Adventure card and Dwelling costs).

Example: One sticker configuration (as used in the rulebook examples) reflects an equal distribution of resources, but you can use any order you choose.

Tray 1: ☁ Air 🌱 Earth 🔥 Fire 💧 Water

Tray 2: ☀ Light 🌑 Darkness 🌀 Order 🌀 Chaos

Adventure Decks, Doorways

Each tray column holds one Adventure card deck of 13 cards. 12 cards feature the same Element back, and 1 card is the Doorway with a unique card back. Separate the Doorway and shuffle the other cards, placing them face-down in the tray, the column that matches their sticker. Then, add the doorway face-down to the top of the deck.

Treasure Token Stacks



Each tray column holds 12 Treasure tokens per Element, face-down in stacks of 3. Cardboard Treasure tokens are provided with the game. If you also own the wood set of Treasure tokens, you will only need one set for the game.
